Jordan has been a growing player in Film and TV production since the establishment of Royal Film Commission in 2003.


Its reputation as a top filming destination skyrocketed after the release of the Academy Award-winning *The Hurt Locker*.

...Safety and Security

Jordan is very safe to visit and, despite issues such as the Syrian refugee crisis and unemployment, you are unlikely to feel any hint of the turmoil of neighboring nations.

King Abdullah II is a respected leader with wide public support for his efforts in introducing democratic reforms, curbing political corruption, and preventing extremism.

Jordan has low levels of crime and the vast majority of hotels have a thorough security system in place that all guests must pass through. Visitors will also note the security personnel and checkpoints among popular areas of the country, especially where tourists frequent.

At least one security officer is present on any film/TV set and is provided at no extra cost to the production. Additional security for hire is always an option.

Incentives

❖ VAT Exemption

The Royal Film Commission offers a VAT exemption, based on a point system that is designed to pass easily.

The VAT in Jordan is 16% on all expenditures such as daily purchases, vehicle rentals, hotels, equipment, etc.

Withholding Tax Exemption

The RFC also allows for an exemption on withholding tax, providing that various criteria are met.

Desert Motion Pictures works with your production to ensure that these exemptions are successfully implemented.

Cash Rebate

In 2018, Jordan introduced a Cash Rebate Incentive.

- ❖10% Cash Back if Total Budget is between 7 Million and 10.5 Million USD
- ❖15% Cash Back if Total Budget is between 10.5 Million and 14 Million USD
- ❖ 20% Cash Back if Total Budget is above 14 Million USD

Desert Motion Pictures consults on ensuring your project meets the terms of rebate eligibility.
